

1. Ramble Round the Back

Distance – 1 mile

Duration: Approx 1 hour with young children

Description – Mostly track and footpaths through woods and past a small waterfall. Views to Stoodley Pike and Rodwell Head. Short section along Cross Stone Road.

Go out the front door and turn immediately right past the farm buildings and farm yard.

At the brow of the low hill, turn first right down the bridle track between the 2 dry stone walls.

Keep straight ahead, follow the dog leg to the right and keep going.

When the track becomes rough, at a small stand of trees, turn right down the footpath.

Follow the footpath round to the left, waterfall below on left hand side.

Keep straight ahead along the path through the small wood and up the hill. As it opens out you will see views down across the valley towards Todmorden.

Keep on the path as it bends to the right and rejoins Cross Stone Road at Bean Hole Head.

Bear right, past Cross Gap, back to Rodwell Head Farm.
